Subject: 2009 Yearly Summary Report

The following is a brief summary of activities and programs the EAC participated in during the past year:

- The EAC held its sixth annual Clean & Green Day on April 18, 2009. Approximately twenty EAC members and township volunteers cleaned up former refuse areas on the grounds of Camp Fernbrook. The glass and metal were separated and recycled.
- The EAC participated in the Coventry Woods Festival on May 31st. The Council provided free wildflower seeds to all attendees plus fifty red oak seedlings were given to children who attended book readings by Pat Washburn and Fred Winter. Adam Sager and family set up a food concession stand and donated all proceeds to the fund to revitalize Camp Fernbrook.
- A grant application was submitted and approved from the Consortium for Scientific Assistance to Watersheds (C-SAW) to provide training that would enable EAC members to monitor stream water quality. The training will take place in 2010.
- The EAC recommend adoption of a LEED Certification ordinance amendment prepared by Adam Sager.
- The EAC provided various GIS maps and reports requested by the Board of Supervisors, Planning Commission, Open Space Review Board and Parks & Recreation Commission. GIS data and assistance was provided to McMahon Assoc. to help fulfill their contract to provide an on-line GIS and permit application system.
